

## EASTGATE SHOPPING CENTRE PH 2 INVERNESS

A major Shopping Development in the Centre of Inverness connected to the existing Shopping Centre by a link bridge which spans the main road.

The link bridge supports shop units as well as providing pedestrian access. A second smaller link bridge connects to the adjoining Safeway Store.



The contract involved the fabrication and erection of the structural steelwork for the main building and the 500 tonne link bridge across the main road, which was erected during weekend possessions.



Also included was the supply and fixing of metal decking and steelwork connections to the reinforced concrete “cores”.



The striking Circular Central Atrium was constructed using hollow circular steel sections and additional architectural features were incorporated at the two main entrances.
