

EAST LEAKE SCHOOLS DEVELOPMENT NOTTINGHAMSHIRE

The redevelopment of an existing site to provide two new schools together with a new leisure centre with swimming pool.

The existing Lantern Lane Primary School is to be extended and the new Harry Carlton Comprehensive School built adjacent to the existing comprehensive school which will then be demolished and the land set aside for future development.



The PFI Project is a two storey development with pitched roof.

The contract involved the fabrication and erection of the structural steelwork together with metal decking, and included the installation of cell beams and the galvanising of specific structural steel members.
